### General Practice Medical Education Fellowships

3 part-time posts (5 sessions) located across the 4 Deanery regional offices.

These posts provide an unparalleled opportunity for recently qualified GPs to become involved in the development, delivery and evaluation of medical education and contribute to the development of a sustainable, fit for purpose primary care workforce in Scotland.

### General Practice Health Inequalities Fellowships

West Region - 1 Full time post (5 sessions in Homeless Practice in Glasgow and 5 sessions in NES)

South-East and East Regions – 2 part time posts (5 sessions, 2 or 3 in the Access Practices and the remainder in NES)

To increase skills in General Practice and to develop specific skills related to Health Inequality which are relevant to the health needs of Scotland. The Fellowship is particularly suited to doctors who have recently completed GP Specialty Training and have some previous experience of working in a deprived area.

Posts are for 12 months. Applications are open to those who will have completed GP Training in the past 5 years.
